CONCLUSIONS OF THE MEETING

ABOUT THE WORKPACKAGES

WP1 is finished (although new pilot farms could be included in the next year if it is necessary).

WP2 (Crop physiology) (it is running properly, but the equipment implementation in LRA and SAPIAMA must be done as soon as possible).

WP3 (Fruit quality) and WP4 (Fruit safety) (it is running properly, but there are some coordination activities that must be considered:

- Exchange of samples and protocols between partners
- New almond and olives orchards with different water quality and fertigation applications.
- Relationship with WP6.2. (new fruit quality parameter must be considered???)

WP4, WP5 and WP6 (Soil and trees models) (it is running properly).

WP7 (Validation of models) (we must wait for the final models development)

WP8 (Disinfection of water by ultrasounds) (it is running properly)(The use of this technique in other countries- Lebanon and Morocco should be considered).

WP9 (Development of sensors for automatic irrigation)(The prototype used by different partners must be described and tested for all partners).

WP10 (Food safety issues) (only some bibliography review has been done until this moment)

WP11 and WP12 (Best management Practices and Sustainability studies) (interesting results from surveys have been obtained in Morocco and Lebanon, but the questionnaire should be the same for all partners).

WP13 (Dissemination) We must try a better relationship with the stakeholders and also to increase the quantity of publications and communications.
